

Shirlal Ananthanatha Swamy Jain Basadi

Shirlal is a small village situated below the Sahyadri Hills (Western Ghats) in the Coastal region of Karnataka State of India. One of the main attractions here is the approximately 300 years old Shirlal Jain temple whose main diety is Ananthanatha Swamy and godess Padmavati Devi. Sorrounded by serene beauty of nature this holy place the Basadi (Jain Temple) has a spacious Gopura, a community hall with a capacity of 750 members and a dining hall, a plantation of Areca, Rubber, Cashewnut and Coconut, a well equipped guest house as well as the main attraction the three statues of Bharata, Bahubali and Adinatha thirthankara.

The Shirlal Jain Temple is offers the following Facilities and services:

Facilities

- Community Hall of 750 capacity with fully equipped dining hall
- Guest Rooms- 10 Fully furnished with attached Bathrooms
- Stay facilities for Munis & Swamijis visiting the Basadi

Services

- Daily Pooja Timings - 10 am to 1 pm
- Special Pooja on every Friday with food served (Annadana).
- Anantha Nopi for 3days performed every year
- Silver Chariot Festival on Akshaya Tritiya.
- Nine days Navaratri Utsava and Deepotsava.

Akshayanidhi- The food is served in the name of the devotee one day in a year. Rs. 5000/-

Nithya Pooja- Yearly once pooja in the name of the devotee. Rs. 250/-
